Jared LaReau Films Pitch ideas for PSA and social media campaigns

Billboard Campaign:

At the time of the meeting, billboard space was available in all areas of the State except Northshore, NOLA Metro, and Unity Areas. After the meeting was over Lamar contacted Richard and said they only had available billboards in the cities as follows:

Billboard content and Art were discussed and decided to send to Lamar graphic artist for their input. **subsequent event: Lamar has returned proofs for Billboards and are attached for review and approval vote by committee.

All billboard traffic will be routed to the individual Areas via YAP/phone and/or websites via the region phone line.

Video PSA Campaign:

Richard handed out a pitch from Jared L's film company (copy attached) but Jared was unable to attend due to work. The PSA will provide NA with a 15 second PSA and 30 second PSA which will be fully owned by NA.

The PSAs will be used for TV, Region & Area Websites, Social Media Sites. The video templates could be manipulated for use in any area. The Regional PR Sub-Committee will approve a script provided by Jared and local addicts can be used in the filming with their faces blurred out. Production should begin as soon as Jared is available with drafts being sent to the Reg PR Committee for approval. A zoom meeting can be held between quarterly meetings to facilitate a faster turnaround time.

Subsequent event: Video PSA will begin production in April 2022.

MOTION: Trevis made a motion to give Jared the approval to start production and send drafts to the Regional PR Committee. Motion was 2nd by Elmore. Vote: unanimous YES.

Social Media Campaign:

A 6-month social media campaign (ran in 30 day increments) will begin as soon as the artwork from Lamar has been approved. These social media posts will for now be a static banner type PSA using the same artwork as the billboards. Once the video PSA is done, we will use those videos on social media sites in addition to or as a replacement to the static posts. Social Media posts will be "boosted" with the target audiences selected for the entire State of LA. Our campaign would reach approximately 160-460 people per week who would be directed to the Region website and phoneline which would then redirect them to the appropriate Areas. There are measurable outcome metrics with social media Platforms. Discussion centered on the importance of using social media to inform the public about Narcotics Anonymous and the cost effectiveness of using social media to attract new membership.

MOTION: Bob S made a motion to approve 6-month campaign. Motion was 2nd by Elmore and the vote was unanimous YES.

Convention Board Report

Ron Duggins has returned the past convention banners to the Northshore area and has the banners from New Orleans ,Unity Area and Acadiana area with him to turn over at the regional meeting this weekend. Board Treasurer

We have had an unfortunate and surprise resignation from the board at our last meeting. Rock Hudson has stepped down as treasurer. He has turned the checkbooks (3), deposit slips, convention laptop, past records, receipt books, square card reader and anything else over to Ron who brought it to the board meeting on the 22nd. Denise Howell will be our acting treasurer until we can elect a replacement. Bob Storer and I are signatures on the account. I will be removing Rock Hudson from the accounts and adding Denise Howell as soon as possible. I would like to thank Rock Hudson for his past contributions to the board.

Board Policy Update:

Bob Storer handed out a draft policy update and emailed copies to those not in attendance. We reviewed the updates and will vote on them at our next meeting with the proposed corrections. Thanks Bob.

Incorporation update

We filed anew for 501 C4 status with the IRS on February 9th, or at least our tax accountant did. We chose C4 over C3 status, for several reasons. There is no advantage for us to have C3 status and the IRS scrutinizes C3 applications much more. Also, our previous Status was 501 C4. We had to make several changes on the application as well as change of addresses. The filing fee to the IRS was \$600.00 and the fee to the CPA was \$1645.00. This included filling out the forms and a history search of our past application and suspension. We will just have to wait for the IRS. The CPA seems confident there will be no hiccup, but I'm a pessimist. This could take several months, the government is not known to be speedy, but we will keep fingers crossed. We will have to put some sort of mechanism in place to assure that this doesn't happen again. Due to the resignation an opening has opened on the board. The requirements are 7 years clean and previous convention experience. The region nominates and elects the board members. I am again including my phone number and email address in case anyone is interest in the convention or has any questions.
